NORTHSHORE USBC BOWLING ASSOCIATION 2010 TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP**. All entrants must be current in their membership in the NorthShore USBC Bowling Association. Non-resident bowlers must be sanctioned at least 30 days prior to the tournament.
2. **HANDICAP**: Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's entering average and 220. Handicap will be calculated for the series.
3. **ENTERING AVERAGE**: Entering average shall be based on their highest NorthShore USBC BA 2008-09 yearbook averages for 21 games or more.
 - A. Bowlers without a 2008-09 NS USBC BA Winter League average, but have a 2009 NS USBC BA Summer League Average shall use the highest summer league average of 21 games or more.
 - B. Bowlers without either a 2008-09 winter league average or a 2009 summer league average shall use their highest current 2009-10 average of 21 games or more in a NorthShore USBC BA certified league, as of January 1, 2010.
 - C. New bowlers in the association, that meet Rule 3 or 3A (women and former youth bowlers that participated in leagues certified with the NorthShore BA will use those averages.

NOTE: Bowlers who do not meet these requirements must use a scratch score of 220 as an entering average. It is the bowler's responsibility to provide average verification and reporting of any tournament prize money winnings. All average adjustments and rerating procedures will be accomplished as required by USBC Rules 319a through 319e (the 10-pin rule will be enforced).
4. **PARTICIPATION**: Multiple participation will be permitted in all tournament events. A bowler's scores from the first official appearance in any event shall count toward their all-events score.
 - A. A team submitting an entry may not have more than two bowlers in their lineup who are also listed on another team roster. At least two bowlers on the team roster must be changed to form a new team.
 - B. Multiple participation in the doubles and singles event will be permitted. All bowlers entered in the doubles event must bowl in the singles event and visa versa. No bowler may place more than once in the prize list for singles position standings.
 - C. REENTRIES – Reentries will be permitted for team and doubles events. Reentries for the team event must be for the same 4 bowlers who entered and bowled for the team's original entry. Reentries for the doubles event must be for the same two bowlers who initially entered together. Reentries for the doubles event require reentry in the singles event.
5. **ALL EVENTS**: There will be optional scratch and handicap All-Event categories. Separate entry fees will be charged and there will be separate prize funds for each.
6. **OPTIONAL SCRATCH EVENTS**: Optional events for Singles/Doubles and Teams are available. Entries into the scratch events must have paid entry into handicap events. Scores bowled in the handicap events will be used for the optional scratch events. All bowlers for a team entering the scratch team event must pay the optional fee. Entry into the scratch doubles does not require both bowlers to enter scratch singles.
7. **CLOSING DATE**: All tournament entries must be paid-in-full and submitted to the NorthShore BA no later than February 28, 2010. Reentries will be accepted, if paid-in-full, no later than 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time of the desired reentry squad.
8. **OFFICIAL SCORES**: Scoring errors occurring during tournament play must be immediately brought to the attention of a tournament official for correction. Violations will result in a score of '0' for the frame. Team captains are responsible for recording the scores on the recap sheets. All recording errors must be reported and corrected within 24 hours of the shift bowled.
9. **CHECK IN TIME**: Team captains and bowlers scheduled for singles/doubles squads must check in with the tournament control desk at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time. All shifts will start at the time specified by the tournament director. No delays due to tardy players will be permitted. Bowlers arriving late will receive a score of '0' for the frames missed.
10. **SHIFT SCHEDULING**: Team Captains and Singles/Doubles Participants are reminded that they must submit a first and second choice of shifts for the events they are entering. While scheduling is normally not a problem, the Tournament Director cannot guarantee that each entry will get their first choice of shifts. The Tournament Director will use the second choice only when the desired squad has been filled or when a lack of entries for a squad make it unfeasible to hold the squad. At least one pair of lanes will be left open as spares in case of mechanical breakdown.
11. **PROTESTS**: All protests concerning the tournament must be filed in writing with the NorthShore USBC Bowling Association within seven days of the closing date of the Tournament.
12. **LANE COURTESY**: During the tournament only one lane courtesy will be given.
